

Automated Safety Warning Controller (USU Task Order 1)

Start Date: 9/1/2018

End Date: 8/30/2020

Budget: \$249,995

Utah State University

Approximately \$112,000 remaining after August 2020.

The project was in its third phase which entailed further developing the ASWC software and installation process to work with the Caltrans Advanced Traffic Controller (ATC) 2070.

Rural Traveler Information / One Stop Shop (USU Task Order 2)

Start Date: 9/1/2018

End Date: 8/30/2020

Budget: \$150,000

Utah State University

Approximately \$62,800 remaining after August 2020.

The One-Stop-Shop for Rural Traveler Information is a web application designed to provide rural travelers with real-time weather and road information for all mainland western states. The project began in 2010 at Montana State University where Dr. Galarus and his team conducted three phases of development. In Fall 2018, the project followed Dr. Galarus to Utah State University (USU), where it completed its fourth phase. The fourth phase of the project continued testing and development of the application and researched long-term maintenance and support of the application. A unified desktop and mobile-friendly version of the application was developed.

ASWSC and One Stop Shop Support (Montana Tech Task Order 1)

Start Date: Summer 2021

Duration: Two Years

Budget: \$60,000

Montana Tech

On-going support will be provided for the Automated Safety Warning System Controller (ASWSC) and One-Stop-Shop (OSS) projects. Project lab development environments will be established at Montana Tech in Butte so that support can be provided for the ASWSC and OSS projects.
